### WHAT IS HOST HOMES?

Host Homes is a customized way to serve adults with disabilities. Our mentors provide daily support to individuals, or “mentees,” in the program and help them work towards their personalized goals in the mentor’s private family home setting.

Host Homes mentors can support up to two mentees with disabilities at the same time. When you become a contracted Host Homes mentor, you create a shared living opportunity that helps them thrive.

### TO BECOME A MENTOR, YOU MUST:

- Be 21 or older
- Own or rent a home, apartment, single-family home, or trailer
- Be able to provide a private bedroom for the individual
- Be available with a flexible schedule to provide oversight and supervision
- Complete and stay up-to-date on required trainings such as CPR/First Aid, Positive Behavior Supports, and mentee-specific trainings

Each person in your home over the age of 18 must be able and willing to go through a thorough screening process.

We ensure each Host Homes mentor is comfortable with the individual placed in their care. We’ll also get to know you and your home to match you with the right mentee for your family.
